NEXT SUNDAY’S READINGS – The Lectionary Texts for The First Sunday in Lent are: The Book of Deuteronomy 26: 1-11; Psalm 91: 1-2, 9-16; The Letter of Paul to the Romans 10: 8b-13; the Gospel according to Luke 4: 1-13.

8 A.M. EUCHARISTIC PRAYER D – is adapted from the Liturgy of St. Basil (c. 379). It is used on feasts of special solemnity in the Greek and Slavic churches and, adapted, among Coptic Christians and in the sacramentary of Paul VI. The text of the prayer up to the institution narrative is a translation of the Latin original from the Roman sacramentary. The institution narrative is that of Prayers A and B. The anamnesis, oblation and epiclesis are those of the earliest known manuscript of the prayer. The petition for the communicants is based on the Roman sacramentary Latin version; the petition for the church is from the earliest manuscript, and the bracketed intercessions are based on those of the Roman sacramentary. Like Eastern and Roman Eucharistic prayers since the fourth century, it provides for intercessions. In this prayer, we have a text of historic and ecumenical significance. (Marion J. Hatchett, 1980)
